Privacy Policy

Your privacy is very important to us. This privacy policy covers any personal information that we obtain from you relating to your membership in the Lawyers Club of Chicago or any e-mail received by the Lawyers Club of Chicago.

We will not use personal information for purposes other than those for which it is collected, except with your consent or as required by law. We may retain the content of e-mails that you send us and our responses in order to handle any follow-up questions you may have.

The Lawyers Club of Chicago does not collect personal information about visitors to our website. The website does not use cookies (pieces of information that a website transfers to your computer's hard drive for recordkeeping purposes).

Any personal information relating to your correspondence with or membership in the Lawyers Club of Chicago (such as your e-mail address, work or residence address, place of employment, telephone number, billing information or application for membership in the Club) shall not be posted on the website or collected for redistribution outside the membership of the Club. However, we may share with a proposed member the names of members of the Club who are affiliated with the proposed member's place of employment.

No billing or payment information will be distributed outside the Lawyers Club of Chicago (except as reasonably needed to process payments) nor shared with any members of the Lawyers Club of Chicago other than the officers and directors of the Club or their delegates.
